COMPLETE WARRANTY INFORMATION

CAT is pleased to provide two extended Warranties on its product Vehicle Corrosion Warranty and System Warranty. The benefits conferred under these warranties are in addition to the rights and remedies conferred under the Australian Consumer Law (ACL).

Vehicle Corrosion Warranty

The CAT System is warranted to help protect the vehicle as identified herein against steel corrosion for a period of ten (10) years from the date the vehicle was manufactured (built) unless the warranty is voided earlier. *(The vehicle manufacturer's compliance Plate shall be used to establish the Build Date)*

What's covered under the Vehicle Corrosion Warranty:

The vehicle body and chassis is covered in accordance with the terms and conditions contained herein but with the following exclusions:

- (a) Engine, Ancillary Fittings, Auxiliary Fittings, Power Drive Train, Exhaust System, Brake System, Electrical System, Suspension, Heating System, Cooling System and all fittings and fastenings associated with these components.
- (b) Vehicle Load Areas (*i.e. utility trays or van load areas*).
- (c) Any vehicle components which are insulated from the vehicle's main body.
- (d) Any damage which has resulted from collision, accident, battery acid, perforation other than rust whether deliberately or accidental.

The Vehicle Corrosion Warranty will be deemed voided if:

- (a) the system has not been installed correctly and in accordance with the installation instructions provided by CAT.
- (b) the system is fitted to a vehicle more than 5 years of age
- (c) the system installed is not suitable for the vehicle or its intended use within an extreme environ. For example but not limited to:-
 - a. Mining and Construction.
 - b. Carriage of hazardous or corrosive materials or chemicals.
 - c. Subjected wholly or partly to salt water (other than beach use for recreational purposes).
- (d) the system is disconnected from its power supply either intentionally or by accident.
- (e) there is internal or external damage to the system either intentionally or by accident.
- (f) the vehicle leaves the Australian territory.
- (g) The vehicle becomes un-registered for longer than 3 months.
- (h) The Vehicle Corrosion Warranty is subject to an enforceable manufacturer's warranty.
- (i) the vehicle is subjected to unreasonable owner abuse or neglect.
- (j) the owner ceases to be the registered owner of the vehicle. (warranty is not transferable)
- (k) the owner breaches any other obligations contained herein.

System Warranty

CAT further warrants the owner that the CAT System (Module) will be free from defects in material and workmanship for the period ending the later of:

- (a) expiry of the Vehicle Corrosion Warranty; or
- (b) five (5) years from the date of purchase of the CAT System.

If CAT deems (at its sole discretion) that a CAT System is defective in material and workmanship during the System Warranty period, CAT will replace the CAT System free of charge.

Owner Obligations

The owner acknowledges that they are aware that the CAT System shall help protect the vehicle against rust or corrosion only for so long as it functions electronically. The owner accordingly undertakes:-

- (a) to periodically check that the unit is functioning, i.e. the green light is Flashing or Solid. If the red light appears either constant or pulsing, or there are no lights at all then a fault condition exists and should be remedied as soon as practical – please consult the trouble shooting guide available on the CAT website www.catsystemsaustralia.com.au or contact CAT for advice .
- (b) to periodically check the Coupler Pads are still attached.
- (c) to periodically check the vehicle for impending rust damage. It is the responsibility of the owner to notify CAT Systems immediately upon noticing any such damage.
- (d) to ensure the system is inspected annually as per the Vehicle Inspection Schedule.

It should be noted that the brown stain (ferric oxide) that develops on and around some paint chips is not rust as such and should be cleaned and repainted at the consumer's earliest convenience.

Vehicle Inspection Schedule:

To maintain the validity of the Vehicle Corrosion Warranty the system must be confirmed as operational by a duly qualified automotive or auto electrical technician every twelve (12) months (within 30 days of the installation anniversary date). Details of each inspection must be recorded in the space provided on this warranty (*Annual Inspection Record*) and will be referenced to confirm the validity of any claim.

Limitation of Liability:

The total cost of repairs during the Corrosion Warranty period is limited \$2,500.00 with a maximum of \$500.00 per any one claim. The Corrosion Warranty does not cover costs incurred due to the loss of use of the vehicle, rental car expenses or any other incidental or consequential loss or damages.

Warranty Claim Procedure:

The owner should first confirm that the claim situation is not covered by an enforceable vehicle manufacturer's warranty. If the owner still considers they have a valid claim under this warranty they should contact CAT Systems Australia within 30 days of becoming aware of the claim situation. CAT Systems Australia shall not be held liable for any repairs undertaken by the owner without its prior written consent.
